

**City of Sammamish
City Council
Study Session Notes
February 9, 2000**

Councilmembers present: Mayor Jack Barry, Deputy Mayor Troy Romero, Councilmembers Phil Dyer, Don Gerend, Kathleen Huckabay, and Kenneth Kilroy

Councilmembers excused: Councilmember Ron Haworth

Mayor Jack Barry opened the Study Session at 8:50 p.m.

King County Library System

Director William Ptacek, County Library staff Claudia McKain, Isabelle Schaller and Sammamish Library Manager John Sheller provided information to Councilmembers on the options for providing library service to the residents of Sammamish. City Manager Wilson recommends that the City Council approve a resolution calling for a ballot issue to annex the City of Sammamish into the King County Library System.

Personnel/Benefits/Finance Issues

Councilmember Dyer moved to adjourn the Study Session. Councilmember Kilroy seconded the motion. The motion failed with two aye votes and four nay votes.

City Manager Wilson reviewed a draft ordinance providing authority for the city Manager to execute certain types of contracts with dollar limitations.

Councilmember Dyer moved to extend the Study Session to 9:40 p.m. or until adjournment. Councilmember Huckabay seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

City Manager Wilson presented proposed changes to the employee medical benefits paid by the City and to the employee salary schedule, explaining what the changes entail. Wilson provided job descriptions for the positions of Engineer, Administrative Assistant, Parks/Recreation Supervisor, Code Enforcement Officer, Building/Fire Official, Special Projects Planner, and Planning Manager that will be on the next agenda for approval.

Councilmember Dyer moved to extend the Study Session to 9:59 p.m. Councilmember Gerend seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Councilmembers briefly discussed items for the February 12, 2000 retreat agenda.
