

**City of Sammamish
City Council Notes
Study Session
January 10, 2001**

Deputy Mayor Ken Kilroy opened the Study Session of the Sammamish City Council at 6:30 pm.

Councilmembers present: Deputy Mayor Ken Kilroy, Councilmembers Jack Barry, Don Gerend, and Ron Haworth.

Councilmembers absent: Mayor Troy Romero, Councilmembers Phil Dyer and Kathleen Huckabay.

Staff present: Interim City Manager Ben Yazici, Transportation Manager Lee Haro and City Clerk Melonie Anderson.

1. Sound Transit Presentation

Bob White, Executive Director of Sound Transit gave a presentation on the current status of Sound Transit. He said even though Sammamish was incorporated after the major projects for Sound Transit were planned there was still opportunity to receive funding for City transportation projects and encouraged Council to pursue these opportunities.

2. City Hall Pre-Design Report

Amy Bailey and David Latrondo of Inform Design Inc. gave the report. The lengthy report presented information on the advantages to the City of constructing their own City Hall as opposed to continuing to rent facilities. 3. Boundary Review Board Vacancy

There are two vacancies on the King County Boundary review board. Applications must be complete by January 19, 2001 and submitted to Council for recommendation.

4. Committee Assignments

A discussion concerning which committees Councilmembers will sit on for the following year took place. The final decisions will be announced at the January 17, 2001 Regular Meeting.
