Mayor opened the study session of the Sammamish City Council at 6:30 p.m.

#### **Public Comment**

*This is an opportunity for the public to address the Council. Three-minutes limit per person or 5 minutes if representing the official position of a recognized community organization.*

Steve Tyzzer, 21318 NE 1<sup>st</sup> Street, Spoke regarding the Barrington subdivision and expressed concern about the development creating a landslide hazard.

David Griffin, 12712 NE 144<sup>th</sup> Street, Apt. 301, Kirkland, Representing the "Not One – Affordable Schools" organization. He spoke regarding the Lake Washington School District bond measure that will be voted on this month. He does not want the City Council to support or endorse this bond.

Mark Cross, 247 208<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE, Spoke regarding the strain increased development has created for City staff. He requested the Council do two things: (1) Reinforce a policy that will not allow water from one drainage basin in the city to be moved to another without really sound reasoning for doing so. (2) Check storm drainage pipes as the City is doing its yearly overlay projects.

Mike Nekreim, 7438 159<sup>th</sup> Place NE, Representing the "Not One-Affordable Schools" Committee. He requested Council not endorse the Lake Washington School District's bond measure.
